CLOTHING

- 1 hoodie/sweatshirt
- 1 flannels/warm long sleeve shirt
- 1 light long sleeve shirt
- 4 t-shirts/tank tops
- 2 pairs of shorts (at least 1 quick dry)
- 1 pairs jeans/pants
- 1pairs sweatpants/leggings
- 1 pairs wool socks
- 4 pairs regular socks
- 1 rain suit (jacket & pants)
- 2 bathing suits
- underwear (1/day + 1 extra)
- 1 buff/bandana
- 2 sun hats
- 1 toque
- 2-4 reusable masks (just in case)
- 1-2 kippas*
- 1-2 pairs of pyjamas

TOILETRIES

- toothbrush & case
- toothpaste & dental floss
- chapstick SPF 15+
- biodegradable shampoo + conditioner
- daily hair care products
- biodgradable bodywash/soap
- biodegradable facewash
- loofa*
- face lotion
- body lotion*
- sunscreen SPF 30+
- bug spray/cream
- additional personal hygiene products*
 - pads/tampons/menstrual cup
 - retainers & case
 - braces elastics & wax
- 2 towels (1 shower, 1 swimming)

BEDDING

- pillowcase
- fitted sheet (single/twin bed)
- flat sheet
- blanket/comforter/sleeping bag

- laundry bag

SHOES

- shower shoes (flip flops/crocs)*
- sport sandals (with a back strap)
- sneakers/running shoes

MISC

- sunglasses (case & strap)
- 1-2 water bottles
- headlamp & flashlight

- string for bracelets*
- mini hand-held fan*
- journal
- stationery

- 2 prescription glasses (if required)

Clothing: ALL CLOTHING and ITEMS MUST BE LABELLED (clothing will be donated if not labelled at end of summer).

BB Camp does not guarantee the return of items or clothing left at camp.

Camper's belongings should ideally be packed in duffel bags (suitcases and trunks are not suited well for the trails!)

Pack belongings in garbage bags/plastic bags within the duffel to keep items dry in case of rain

BB Camp has a ready to play clothing and swimsuit policy. All clothing, swimsuits, and footwear should allow for campers to fully participate in camp activities comfortably without getting caught in equipment, or falling off.

ELECTRONICS AT CAMP

OUR ELECTRONICS POLICY IS DESIGNED TO

- Encourage your children to spend more time off their beds and outdoors
- Promote socialization between campers
- Remove the divide between “the haves, and the have-nots” in each cabin
- Reduce the stress associated with the damage to and theft of electronics
- Give your children a much needed break from the world of technology
- Ensure that your children are not exposed to age-inappropriate material
- Reflect the extremely limited availability of power outlets in the cabin

PORTABLE MUSIC PLAYERS

We will not allow any MP3 players/mobile devices with touch screens. This way we can ensure that our campers cannot watch videos, TV shows, movies or access the internet. Campers may not bring any smart phones, even if the SIM card has been removed.

If your child must have his/her music at Camp, either to help with sleep or Bar/Bat Mitzvah preparation, please send:

A CD player and CDs, an inexpensive mp3 player, or an older generation iPod that doesn't have a touch screen.

CELLPHONES

We feel cell phone use at Camp is counter to the values we teach and uphold at BB Camp and interferes with an important peer aspect of the overnight camp experience. Using a cell phone is not why you send your child here.

We have a **zero-tolerance** cellphone policy. If any camper has a cell phone in Camp, it will be confiscated and stored in the Camp's Director office until the end of the session

DIGITAL CAMERAS

We encourage you to send an inexpensive digital camera or disposable cameras. Please discuss proper handling of the camera and how pictures should only be taken of people with their permission.

OTHER ELECTRONICS

No devices that connect to the internet, or that have touch screens are permitted at camp. Each cabin has access to arts and craft supplies board games and card games for down time in the cabin.
