Summary

The Kitchen Coordinator ensures that the Junior food service team is adequately fulfilling their duties in the kitchen. Kitchen Coordinator will assist the Food Service Director in the ordering and execution of all menus and meals.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Ensure all meals and snacks are prepared and served on time and in appropriate quantities
- Ensure all dietary restrictions and allergies are accommodated.
- Train and supervise food service team.
- Ensure Jr kitchen staff are supported and that clear expectations are outlined for them
- Assist in ensuring camp kitchen is cleaned and maintained in compliance with Ontario Health Code Standards.
- Coordinate meal planning with Wilderness team and ensure depot is adequately stocked for canoe trips.

- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to work with children in building self-esteem and self-confidence.
