Summary

The Camp photographer is responsible for documenting the daily goings on at camp through our website, and social media channels. The intent of this position is to enhance the services we offer to our parents by posting photos of their children at camp. The photographer is required to work independently, with minimal supervision. The Photographer lives on site for the duration fo their work term.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Capture candid shots at meals, in lineups, around the cabin areas, during daily rotations and during special activities.
- Altering photos for uploading to social media pages.
- Create and execute daily schedules for ensuring all of our campers are photographed equally.
- Take a cabin/trip photo of each cabin/trip.
- Plan and create a camper slideshow each session.
- Plan and create a staff slideshow.
- Other duties as instructed.

Knowledge Skills and Abilities

- Experience with portrait, landscape and sport photography.
- Capable of thinking on one's feet and adapting to changes in scheduling.
- A disciplined, self-starter, demonstrating initiative and the ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- A strong interest in working with children as the interaction between photographer and camper is key for the best shots!

Skills and Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age, or completed grade 12
- Current CPR C and Standard First Aid

Physical Aspects of the Position
